Situated at Kong Meng San ("Bright Hill"), Kong Meng San Phor Kark See Monastery (KMSPKS) was the first traditional Chinese forest monastery in Singapore. With a history of 87 years, it's currently the largest temple in Singapore and one of the most significant and renowned Buddhist monasteries in Southeast Asia. The building structures are an interesting and unique combination of Chinese art, aesthetics and Southeast Asian architectural styles. For the past 20 years, more than 6000 people from all walks of life have taken refuge in the Triple Gem here. Come and explore this haven for yourself and discover why it has a special place in the hearts of many Singaporeans – Buddhists and non-Buddhists alike.
